

Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation For the Academic Year 2024 (Early Admission Round)

1. Applicant Qualifications and Application Requirements

Applicants completed high school or are currently in the final year of high school (Matayom 6 in Thai system, Grade 12 in the US system or Year 13 in the British/IB system) or passed an equivalent high school standard test.

2. Application Requirements

2.1 Applicants must achieve the minimum score of any of the following English proficiency tests (scores are valid within two years from the test dates) to meet the requirement. Applicants can submit more than one English proficiency test result.

2.2 Applicants must achieve the minimum score of any of the following Mathematics proficiency test (scores are valid within two years from the test date) to meet the requirement. Applicants can submit more than one Mathematics proficiency test result.

-	SAT (Mathematics)	not lower than	640	or
-	ACT (Math)	not lower than	27	or
_	CU-AAT Math	not lower than	620	



If an applicant chooses to submit both parts of SAT (Evidence-Based Reading & Writing and Math), ACT (American College Testing Assessment - English and Math), the scores must be from the same test (taken on the same day).

If one does not pass the proficiency test score in either items 2.1 or items 2.2, they must obtain a combined score from one of these tests not lower than the specified requirement, as follows.

- SAT Composite Score not lower than 1300 or

- Overall GED Score not lower than 700

All scores pertaining to items 2.1 and items 2.2 must not be older than 2 years on the application deadline.

- 2.3 Applicants must submit E-Portfolio which consists of a collection of the applicants' work as well as activities. The purpose of the E-Portfolio is for applicants to demonstrate individual versatility, breadth of experiences, engagements, achievements, and organizational skills. E-Portfolio can include:
 - 1) Summary of profile
 - 2) Education background
 - 3) Academic or research projects
 - 4) Awards and competitions
 - 5) Scientific or Arts and Design projects: a range of projects such as prototypes, scientific initiatives, drawings, paintings, collage, photography, sculpture, model, performance, or sketchbook pages
 - 6) Business, marketing, branding, sale, or fundraising
 - 7) Any forms of digital media, animation, film, VDOs and audios created.

 Online platforms e.g., YouTube, Instagram, blogs are encouraged.
 - 8) Internships or past work experiences
 - 9) Abroad experiences: exchange programs, internships, international workshops, and summer camps
 - 10) Social or Community activities and projects
 - 11) Extracurricular activities: events/special abilities, such as sports, music, theatre, or marathon
 - 12) Continuing education (short courses or certificates)
 - 13) Creativity & Innovation ideas



E-Portfolio must be created and submitted via the CSII online admission system (https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program) only.

3. Admission numbers

Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will admit **80 qualified students** to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program for the Early Admission Round (Academic Year 2024).

4. Application Documents

Applicants must complete all required sections in the online application system and must ensure the correctness of all the information given. All application forms must be accompanied by the following:

- 1) In case an applicant has completed high school, submit a copy of the diploma from the school and academic transcript(s)
- 2) A student photo (maximum 10 MB file size)
- 3) Test results of items 2.1 and items 2.2
- 4) A copy of transcripts or high school certificate equivalency
- 5) E-Portfolio (items 2.3)
- 6) A copy of Thai ID
- 7) In case of being currently in the final year of high school, a copy of official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is required.
- 8) Name change official document (in case an applicant has different names in application documents)
- 9) Money transfer slip
- 10) A request form for test application at Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center

When the application is submitted, it implies that the applicant has already verified the requirements. No refunds will be made after the application has been submitted.



5. Evaluation Criteria

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the test scores, E-portfolio, and the aptitude test & interview results. Only short-listed candidates will be contacted for interviews. The weighting assigned to the four criteria is as follows:

 Aptitude Test and Assessment 	20 %
E-Portfolio and Interview	30 %
Mathematics proficiency test score	30 %
English proficiency test score	20 %

6. Enrollment

In order to be eligible to enroll at Chulalongkorn University, applicants must have successfully completed Matayom 6 in Thai system or its equivalent level. Applicants who have graduated from schools outside of Thailand or passed an equivalent high school standardized test need to obtain an equivalency certificate from Chulalongkorn University via https://hsces.atc.chula.ac.th.
