



**Chulalongkorn University Announcement on Admission to
Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation
Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation
Academic Year 2024 (International Round)**

Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation is now accepting applications from international students (holders of foreign passports or holders of non-Thai citizenship) to Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program for the Academic Year 2024.

The application process is as follows.

1. Qualifications and Requirements

Applicants must be **non-Thai citizens** (holding foreign passports) who have completed high school or are currently in the final year of high school (Matayom 6 in Thai system, Grade 12 in the US system, or Year 13 in the British/IB system) or passed an equivalent high school standardized test.

1.1 Applicants must submit all documents of the following qualifications:

1.1.1 Applicants must achieve at least the minimum score of any of the following English proficiency tests (scores are valid within two years from the test dates). Applicants may submit more than one English proficiency

Foreign applicants may be considered for a waiver of English proficiency requirements with sufficient proof and relevant experiences, whose secondary education (high school) took place in an accredited school where English is a principal language of instruction for at least three years prior to this application in a native English-speaking country listed below:

Each case will be reviewed individually, and the school reserves the right to request applicants to further satisfy English proficiency requirements if deemed necessary.



1.1.2 Applicants must achieve at least the minimum score of any of the following Mathematics proficiency tests (scores are valid within two years from the test dates) Applicants can submit more than one Mathematics.

- SAT (Math) not lower than 600 or
- ACT (American College Testing Assessment) Math not lower than 25 or
- CU-AAT Math not lower than 580 or
- IB Diploma (International Baccalaureate) HL Math not lower than 5 or
- A-Level Math not lower than Grade B or
- Online Mathematics Placement Test (OMPT-B) not lower than 65% or
- Gaokao Math not lower than 70 or
- HKDSE Math not lower than Level 4 or
- General Scholastic Ability Test (GSAT or Xue Ce) not lower than 10 or
- Russian Unified State Examination (EGE) Math Specialization Level not lower than 70

If an applicant chooses to submit both parts of SAT (Evidence-Based Reading & Writing and Math), ACT (American College Testing Assessment – English, Reading and Math), Gaokao (English and Math), HKDSE (English and Math), General Scholastic Ability Test (GSAT or Xue Ce) (English and Math), the scores must be from the same test (i.e. taken on the same day).

For applicants who eligible under 1 out of the 2 items, they must obtain a score in the section that does not meet the criteria no less than the requirement score. This is to be used to consider and decide on the eligibility of applicants according to the criteria stated in section 5.

If one does not pass the proficiency test score in either items 1.1.1 or 1.1.2, they must obtain a combined score from one of these tests not less than the specified requirement, as follows:

- SAT Composite Score not lower than 1300 or
- Overall GED Score not lower than 700



All scores pertaining to sections 1.1.1 and 1.1.2 must not be older than two years on the application deadline.

1.2 E-Portfolio

Applicants must submit E-Portfolio which consists of collection of the applicants' work as well as activities. E-Portfolio must be created and submitted via the CSII online admission system (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) only.

2. Admission Seats

Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will admit **20** qualified students to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program for this International Round in the Academic Year 2024.

3. Admission Schedule and Fees

3.1 Schedule of Online Application via website (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>)

- First Round: between 25 December 2023 - 5 February 2024
- Second Round (if any): between 20 March 2024 – 10 May 2024

* The second round of international admission will be open if there are still remaining seats after the completion of the first round.

3.2 Schedule of Application Fee Payment

- Applicants of the first round must pay the application fee between 25 December 2023 - 5 February 2024
- Applicants of the second round must pay the application fee between 20 March 2024 – 10 May 2024

3.3 Application Fee

Application fee is 1,500 Thai Baht (One Thousand and Five Hundred Thai Baht), excluding bank and transfer fees.

4. Application Documents

Applicants must complete all required sections in the online application system and must ensure the correctness of all the information given. All application forms must be accompanied by the following:

- 1) In case applicant has completed high school, a certified copy of diploma certificate from the high school and academic transcript(s) is required.
- 2) A student photo (maximum 10 MB file size)
- 3) Test results (1.1.1 and 1.1.2)
- 4) A certified copy of transcript(s) or high school certificate equivalency

- 5) E-Portfolio (1.2)
- 6) A certified copy of foreign passport
- 7) In case applicant is currently in the final year of high school, a copy of official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is required.
- 8) Name change official document (in case applicant has a different name in application documents)
- 9) Upload money transfer slip via <https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program> with the present of applicant's full name.

When the application is submitted, it implies that the applicant has already verified the requirements. No refunds will be made after the application has been submitted.

5. Selection Process

5.1 Evaluation Criteria for First Round

5.1.1 Interview Shortlist Announcement

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will publish the interview shortlist announcement no later than 12 February 2024 via website (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) along with details of the interview.
- Each application will be evaluated on the admission criteria and test scores pertaining to sections 1.1.1 and 1.1.2. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interviews.
- The application will be rejected if the required scores are not submitted in our platform (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) within the application deadline.
- The announced number of applicants shortlisted for interview may be greater than the intended number of students to be admitted to the program due to the expectation of some applicants who fail to show up for the interview or who fail to confirm the enrollment.

5.1.2 The Aptitude Test and Interview

Interviews for the shortlisted applicants will be held **between 16 - 20 February 2024**. Applicants who fail to show up for the aptitude test and interview on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.

5.1.3 Accepted Candidates Announcement

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will upload accepted candidates' announcement on **26 February 2024** via website (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) along with details of the enrollment confirmation.
- Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the test scores, E-Portfolio, online aptitude test and interview results. The following weighting will be assigned to the four criteria as follows:

● English Proficiency Test Score	20 %
● Mathematics Proficiency Test Score	30 %
● E-Portfolio and Interview	30 %
● Aptitude test and Assessment	20 %
Total	100 %

The number of accepted candidates may be higher than the announced quota if the bottom-line candidates have identical scores according to requirements 1.1.1 and 1.1.2.

5.1.4 Enrollment Confirmation and Confirmation Fee

- Accepted candidates must confirm the enrollment within **1 March 2024 – 7 March 2024** via an online platform (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>).
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Enrollment confirmation will be completed with a tuition fee deposit payment of 100,000 Thai Baht (One Hundred Thousand Thai Baht). The tuition fee deposit will be deducted afterwards from the first semester tuition fee.
- Accepted candidates who have already paid the confirmation fee in the first round will not be able to apply for the second round. **No refunds will be made after the enrollment confirmation has been submitted.**

5.1.5 Announcement of Candidates on the Waiting List

- Applicants who are announced to be on the waiting list must confirm the acceptance of offer for enrollment at Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program and pay the confirmation fee **between 8 – 12 March 2024.**

- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.

5.2 Evaluation Criteria for Second Round

5.2.1 Interview Shortlist Announcement

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will announce interview shortlist announcement **no later than 17 May 2024** via website (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) along with details of the interview.
- Each application will be evaluated on the admission criteria and test scores pertaining to sections 1.1.1 and 1.1.2. Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interviews.
- The application will be rejected if the required scores are not submitted in our platform (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) by the application deadline.

5.2.2 The Aptitude Test and Interview

Interviews for the shortlisted applicants will be held **between 21 – 24 May 2024** (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>). Applicants who fail to show up for the aptitude test and interview on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.

5.2.3 Accepted Candidates Shortlist Announcement

Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will upload accepted candidates shortlist announcement **on 30 May 2024** via website (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) along with details of the enrollment confirmation.

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the test scores, E-Portfolio, online aptitude test and interview results. The following weighting will be assigned to

The number of accepted candidates may be higher than the announced quota if the bottom-line candidates have identical scores according to requirements 1.1.1 and 1.1.2.

5.2.4 Enrollment Confirmation and Confirmation Fee

- Accepted candidates must confirm the enrollment within **4 – 10 June 2024** via an online platform (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>)
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Enrollment confirmation will be completed with a tuition fee deposit payment of 100,000 Thai Baht (One Hundred Thousand Thai Baht). The tuition fee deposit will be deducted afterwards from the first semester tuition fee. No refunds will be made after the enrollment confirmation has been submitted.

5.2.5 Announcement of Candidates on the Waiting List

- Applicants who are announced to be on the waiting list must confirm the acceptance of offer for enrollment in Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation program and pay the confirmation fee **between 11 – 12 June 2024**.
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.

6. **Admitted Candidate Announcement for First and Second International Admission Round**
Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will announce the final list of admitted candidates (non-Thai nationals) to enroll in Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation program, Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation, in Academic Year 2024 on **20 June 2024** via website (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>).

The Committee's decision is considered final.

7. Enrollment Condition

- 7.1 To be eligible to enroll for first registration as university students, enrollees must have successfully completed Matayom 6 in Thai system or its equivalent level. In case the University finds out that applicants have not graduated or have not fulfilled any requirement under the admission criteria, the eligibility of applicants to enroll shall be void and the University reserves the right not to refund the application fee, confirmation fee, and tuition fee in any case. For applicants who have graduated from international schools in Thailand or from schools outside of Thailand which are not certified by the Thai Ministry of Education, applicants will need to obtain an equivalency certification by the Thai Ministry of Education, applicants will need to obtain an equivalency certification from Chulalongkorn University via website (<https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th>), in certifying the equivalency with the Thai education system.
- 7.2 Individuals who have completed their education at an international school or a foreign school that was not certified by the Ministry of Education must have their qualification certified by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand as being equal to a qualification according to the Ministry of Education's Basic Education Core Curriculum.
- 7.3 In the presence of any falsification of documents, forgery, or fraud in registration, the student status will be terminated, and the University may consider taking legal action against the admitted applicant.

8. Scholarship

The admitted candidates (non-Thai citizens holding foreign passports) are eligible to apply for the scholarships with the Announcement of the Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation.

9. Tuition Fee

University fees and program tuition fees are charged in accordance with the Announcement of Chulalongkorn University.
