



**Chulalongkorn University Announcement on Admission to
Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International Program)
Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation
Academic Year 2026 (International Round)**

Chulalongkorn University is now accepting applicants from international students (holders of foreign passports or holders of non-Thai citizenship) to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International Program) for the Academic Year 2026. The application process is as follows.

1. Qualifications and Requirements

1.1 Applicants must be **non-Thai citizens** (holding foreign passports or holders of non-Thai citizenship) who have completed high school **or** are currently in the final year of high school (Matayom 6 in Thai system, Grade 12 in the US system, or Year 13 in the British/IB system) **or** passed an equivalent high school standardized test.

1.2 Applicants must submit all documents of the 2 following standardized tests:

1.2.1 Applicants must achieve at least the minimum score of any of the following English proficiency tests. Applicants may submit more than one English proficiency

Please note that IELTS scores from retake sessions will NOT be considered for admission.

Foreign applicants may be considered for a waiver of English proficiency requirements with sufficient proof and relevant experiences, whose secondary education (high school) took place in an accredited school where English is a principal language of instruction for at least three years prior to this application in a native English-speaking country listed below:

Each case will be reviewed individually, and the school reserves the right to request applicants to further satisfy English proficiency requirements if deemed necessary.



1.2.2 Applicants must achieve at least the minimum score of any of the following Mathematics proficiency tests. Applicants may submit more than one Mathematics proficiency.

- SAT (Mathematics)	not lower than	600	or
- ACT (Math)	not lower than	25	or
- CU-AAT (Math Section)	not lower than	580	or
- IB Diploma - HL Math (International Baccalaureate)	not lower than	5	or
- A-Level Math	not lower than	Grade B	or
- Online Mathematics Placement Test (OMPT-B)	not lower than	65%	or
- Gaokao Math	not lower than	70	or
- HKDSE Math	not lower than	Level 4	or
- General Scholastic Ability Test (GSAT or Xue Ce)	not lower than	10	or
- Russian Unified State Examination (EGE) Math Specialization Level	not lower than	70	or

If an applicant chooses to submit the scores from both sections of SAT (Evidence-Based Reading & Writing and Math), ACT (American College Testing Assessment – English, Reading and Math), Gaokao (English and Math), HKDSE (English and Math), General Scholastic Ability Test (GSAT or Xue Ce) (English and Math), the scores must be from the same test (i.e. taken on the same day).

For applicants who do not meet the criteria outlined in items 1.2.1 or 1.2.2 (1 of the 2 items), they must achieve at least the minimum score on one of the following composite scores from the specified tests to be used to consider and decide on the eligibility of applicants according to the criteria stated in section 5.

1) Applicants must achieve at least the minimum score of any of the composite score.

- SAT Composite Score	not lower than	1300	or
- Overall GED Score	not lower than	700	

All scores pertaining to sections 1.2.1, 1.2.2, and 1) must not be older than two years on the application deadline.



- 1.3 Applicants must submit E-Portfolio which consists of collection of the applicants' work as well as activities. **E-Portfolio** must be created and submitted via the CSII Admission Platform (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) only.
- 1.4 Applicants must demonstrate good behavior and certify to the university their commitment to studying to the best of their ability, agreeing to fully comply with all current and future university regulations.

If it is later found that the applicant lacks the required qualifications, has provided false information, or submitted false or forged documents, The school reserves the right to revoke their right to participate in the selection process, even if they have applied or been selected. Furthermore, the applicant may be subject to legal prosecution.

2. Admission Seat

Chulalongkorn University will admit **30 (Thirty)** qualified students to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International Program) for the International Rounds of the Academic Year 2026.

3. Admission Schedule and Fees

3.1 Schedule of Online Application via CSII Admission Platform Website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>)

- First Round: between 22 December 2025 – 6 February 2026
- Second Round (if any): between 20 March – 1 May 2026

***Remark:** The second round of international admission will be open if there are still remaining seats after the completion of the first round.

3.2 Schedule of Application Fee Payment

Application must pay the application fee between the specified period of time.

- First Round: between 22 December 2025 – 6 February 2026
- Second Round (if any): between 20 March – 1 May 2026

3.3 Application Fee

Application fee is 1,500 Thai Baht (One Thousand and Five Hundred Thai Baht), excluding bank and transfer fees.

4. Application Documents

- 4.1 Applicants must complete all required sections in the CSII Admission Platform (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) and must ensure the correctness of all the information given.
- 4.2 A copy of High School Completion, a certified copy of diploma certificate from the high school and academic transcript(s)



In case applicant is currently in the final year of high school, a copy of official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is required.

If the applicant has graduated from an institution abroad or holds an equivalent qualification, they must attach a copy of the high school equivalency certificate or a provisional equivalency certificate. For more information, please visit <https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th/>

- 4.3 A student photo in .jpg format with a maximum of 10 MB file size. (A full-face photo with a white or blue background, not wearing a hat or sunglasses, in formal attire, taken within the last 6 months.)
- 4.4 Test results from 1.2.1 and 1.2.2 and/or 1) (if any)
- 4.5 E-Portfolio (1.3)
- 4.6 A certified copy of foreign passport
- 4.7 Name change official document (in case applicant has a different name in application documents)
- 4.8 Upload money transfer slip via CSII Admission Platform with the present of applicant's full name.

When the application is submitted, it implies that the applicant has already verified the requirements. No refunds will be made after the application has been submitted.

5. Selection Process

5.1 Evaluation Criteria for First Round

5.1.1 Announcement of Selected Candidates for Aptitude Test, Interview, and Team Spirit Assessment

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will publish the announcement of selected candidates for aptitude test, interview, and team dynamic assessment on **11 February 2026** via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) along with details of the aptitude test, interview, team dynamic assessment.
- Each application will be evaluated on the admission criteria and test scores pertaining to sections 1.2.1, 1.2.2., and 1) (if any). Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interviews.
- The application will be rejected if the required scores are not submitted in our platform (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) within the application deadline.



- The announced number of applicants shortlisted for interview may be greater than the intended number of students to be admitted to the program due to the expectation of some applicants who fail to show up for the interview or who fail to confirm the enrollment.

5.1.2 Aptitude Test, Interview, and Team Dynamic Assessment

- Aptitude test, interview, and team dynamic assessment for the selected candidates will be held **between 16 - 20 February 2026**. Applicants who fail to show up for the Aptitude test, interview, and team dynamic assessment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission

5.1.3 Announcement of Accepted Candidates

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will publish an Announcement of Accepted candidates on **24 February 2026** via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) along with details of the enrollment confirmation.
- Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the proficiency test scores, aptitude test, E-portfolio and interview, and Team Dynamic Assessment.

The following weighting will be assigned as follows:

● English Proficiency Test Score (items 1.2.1 or 1))	20%
● Mathematics Proficiency Test Score (items 1.2.2 or 1))	30%
● E-Portfolio (items 1.3) and Interview	15%
● Team Dynamic Assessment	15%
● Aptitude Test	20%

Students are required to attend the session to which they are assigned. All candidates must attend the assessments. Absence from any part of the assessment will result in disqualification from the application process.

The number of accepted candidates may be higher than the announced quota if the bottom-line candidates have identical scores according to requirements 1.2.1 and 1.2.2.

5.1.4 Enrollment Confirmation and Confirmation Fee

- Accepted candidates must confirm the enrollment within **26 February – 3 March 2026** via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>)
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.



- Enrollment confirmation will be completed with a tuition fee deposit payment of 100,000 Thai Baht (One Hundred Thousand Thai Baht). The tuition fee deposit will be deducted afterwards from the first semester tuition fee.
- Accepted candidates who have already paid the confirmation fee in the first round will not be able to apply for the second round. **No refunds will be made after the enrollment confirmation has been submitted.**

5.1.5 Enrollment Confirmation for the Waitlist Candidates

- Applicants who are announced to be on the waiting list must confirm the acceptance of offer for enrollment at Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program and pay the confirmation fee **between 4 – 9 March 2026**.
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Enrollment confirmation will be completed with a tuition fee deposit payment of 100,000 Thai Baht (One Hundred Thousand Thai Baht). The tuition fee deposit will be deducted afterwards from the first semester tuition fee.
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Accepted candidates who have already paid the confirmation fee in the first round will not be able to apply for the second round. **No refunds will be made after the enrollment confirmation has been submitted.**

5.2 Evaluation Criteria for Second Round

5.2.1 Announcement of Selected Candidates for Aptitude Test, Interview, and Team Spirit Assessment

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will publish the announcement of selected candidates for aptitude test, interview, and team spirit assessment on **7 May 2026** via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) along with details of the aptitude test, interview, team spirit assessment.
- Each application will be evaluated on the admission criteria and test scores pertaining to sections 1.2.1, 1.2.2., and 1) (if any). Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted for interviews.



- The application will be rejected if the required scores are not submitted in our platform (<https://csii.chula.ac.th/bascii-program>) within the application deadline.
- The announced number of applicants shortlisted for interview may be greater than the intended number of students to be admitted to the program due to the expectation of some applicants who fail to show up for the interview or who fail to confirm the enrollment.

5.2.2 Aptitude Test, Interview, and Team Spirit Assessment

- Aptitude test, interview, and team spirit assessment for the selected candidates will be held **between 11 - 15 May 2026**. Applicants who fail to show up for the Aptitude test, interview, and team spirit assessment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission

5.2.3 Announcement of Accepted Candidates

- Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will publish an Announcement of Accepted candidates on **19 May 2026** via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>) along with details of the enrollment confirmation.
- Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the proficiency test scores, aptitude test, E-portfolio and interview, and Team Spirit Assessment. The following weighting will be assigned as follows:

• English Proficiency Test Score (items 1.2.1 or 1))	20%
• Mathematics Proficiency Test Score (items 1.2.2 or 1))	30%
• E-Portfolio (items 1.3) and Interview	15%
• Team Spirit Assessment	15%
• Aptitude Test	20%

The number of accepted candidates may be higher than the announced quota if the bottom-line candidates have identical scores according to requirements 1.2.1 and 1.2.2.

5.2.4 Enrollment Confirmation and Confirmation Fee

- Accepted candidates must confirm the enrollment within **21 – 26 May 2026** via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>)
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Enrollment confirmation will be completed with a tuition fee deposit payment of 100,000 Thai Baht (One Hundred Thousand Thai Baht). The



tuition fee deposit will be deducted afterwards from the first semester tuition fee.

- Accepted candidates who have already paid the confirmation fee in the first round will not be able to apply for the second round. **No refunds will be made after the enrollment confirmation has been submitted.**

5.2.5 Enrollment Confirmation for the Waitlist Candidates

- Applicants who are announced to be on the waiting list must confirm the acceptance of offer for enrollment at Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program and pay the confirmation fee **between 27 May - 1 June 2026.**
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Enrollment confirmation will be completed with a tuition fee deposit payment of 100,000 Thai Baht (One Hundred Thousand Thai Baht). The tuition fee deposit will be deducted afterwards from the first semester tuition fee.
- Applicants who do not confirm the enrollment on the specified date and time will forfeit their opportunity for admission.
- Accepted candidates who have already paid the confirmation fee in the first round will not be able to apply for the second round. **No refunds will be made after the enrollment confirmation has been submitted.**

6. Announcement of Admitted Candidates for First and Second Round of the International Admission

Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will announce the admitted candidates (International Round) to enroll in Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International program), Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation, in Academic Year 2026 on 10 June 2026 via CSII Admission Platform website (<https://www.csiiadmission.com>)

The Committee's decision is considered final.

7. Enrollment Condition

- 7.1 To be eligible to enroll for online first-entry registration as university students, enrollees must have successfully completed Matayom 6 in Thai system or its



equivalent level. In case the University finds out that applicants have not graduated or have not fulfilled any requirement under the admission criteria, the eligibility of applicants to enroll shall be void and the University reserves the right not to refund the application fee, confirmation fee, and tuition fee in any case.

For applicants who have graduated from international schools in Thailand or from schools outside of Thailand which are not certified by the Thai Ministry of Education, applicants will need to obtain an equivalency certification by the Thai Ministry of Education, applicants will need to obtain an equivalency certification from Chulalongkorn University in certifying the equivalency with the Thai education system (for more information please visit website <https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th>)

- 7.2 Individuals who have completed their education at an international school or a foreign school that was not certified by the Ministry of Education must have their qualification certified by the Council of University Presidents of Thailand as being equal to a qualification according to the Ministry of Education's Basic Education Core Curriculum
- 7.3 In the presence of any falsification of documents, forgery, or fraud in registration, the student status will be terminated, and the University may consider taking legal action against the admitted applicant.

8. Scholarship

The admitted candidates (holders of foreign passports or holders of non-Thai citizenship) are eligible to apply for the scholarships with the Announcement of the Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation.

9. Tuition Fee

University fees and program fees are charged in accordance with the Announcement of Chulalongkorn University.
