



Announcement on Admission to
Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation (International Program)
Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation
Chulalongkorn University
For the Academic Year 2026 (Early Admission Round)

1 Qualification and Requirement

1.1 Applicants must have completed high school **OR** are currently in the final year of high school (Matayom 6 in Thai system, Grade 12 in the US system, **OR** Year 13 in the British/IB system) **OR** passed an equivalent high school standardized test.

1.2 Applicants must submit BOTH English and Mathematics proficiency tests with the minimum score achieved to meet the requirement.

1.2.1 Applicants must achieve the minimum score of any of the following English proficiency tests (scores are valid within two years from the test dates) to meet the requirement. Applicants can submit more than one English proficiency test result.

Please note that IELTS scores from retake sessions will NOT be considered for admission.

1.2.2 Applicants must achieve the minimum score of any of the following Mathematics proficiency test (scores are valid within two years from the test date) to meet the requirement. Applicants can submit more than one Mathematics proficiency test result.

If an applicant chooses to submit scores for both parts of the SAT (Evidence-Based Reading & Writing and Math) or the ACT (English and Math), the scores must be from the same test date.

For applicants who pass ONLY one of the proficiency tests mentioned above, they may use the following scores to fulfill the missing requirement

1) Applicants MUST achieve one of the following composite scores to fulfill the requirement.

- SAT Composite Score not lower than 1300 or
- Overall GED Score not lower than 700

All scores submitted for items 1.2.1, 1.2.2, and 1) must be at most two years old as of the application deadline.

1.3 Applicants MUST submit an E-Portfolio via the CSII online admission platform (<https://www.csiiadmission.com/>) only. The E-portfolio should include academic activities, seminars, projects, curricular and extracurricular activities, etc.

1.4 Application Documents

Applicants MUST complete all required sections in the online application platform and ensure all the information given is correct. All application forms must be accompanied by the following:

1.4.1 Qualification Identification

- In case an applicant has completed high school, submit a copy of the diploma from the school and academic transcript(s)
- In case of being currently in the final year of high school, a copy of official document certifying academic status from the applicant's school is required.

1.4.2 A student photo (maximum 10 MB file size)

1.4.3 Test results of items 2.1, items 2.2, and items 1)

1.4.4 A copy of transcripts or high school certificate equivalency

1.4.5 E-Portfolio (items 2.3)

1.4.6 A copy of Thai ID

1.4.7 Name change official document

(in case an applicant has different names in application documents)

1.4.8 Money transfer slip

1.4.9 A request form for test application at Chulalongkorn University Academic Testing Center

1.5 Applicants must demonstrate good conduct and comply with all university regulations, with full commitment to their studies.

When the application is submitted, it implies that the applicant has already verified the requirements. No refunds will be made after the application has been submitted.

If it is later found that an applicant is unqualified or has provided false or misleading information, the university reserves the right to disqualify or revoke admission, even after enrollment, and may pursue legal action if necessary.

2 Admission Intakes

Chulalongkorn School of Integrated Innovation will accept **85 qualified students** to the Bachelor of Arts and Science in Integrated Innovation Program for the Early Admission Round (Academic Year 2026).

3 Evaluation Criteria

Eligible applicants will be evaluated on the proficiency test scores, E-portfolio & interview, team spirit assessment, and aptitude test score. The weighting assigned to the five criteria is as follows:

3.1 English proficiency test score	20 %
3.2 Mathematics proficiency test score	30 %
3.3 E-Portfolio and Interview	15 %
3.4 Team Dynamic Assessment	15 %
3.5 Aptitude Test	20 %
Total	100 %

Students are required to attend the session to which they are assigned. All candidates must attend the assessments in person. Absence from any part of the assessment will result in disqualification from the application process.

4 Enrollment

To be eligible to enroll at Chulalongkorn University, applicants must have successfully completed Matayom 6 in Thai system or its equivalent level. Applicants who have graduated from schools outside of Thailand or passed an equivalent high school standardized test need to obtain an equivalency certificate from Chulalongkorn University via <https://hscs.atc.chula.ac.th>.
